





### From the Alps to the Andes

# Alpaca and lama walk

Dive into the world of alpacas and lamas, learn interesting facts about these small camels and touch their soft wool. Get up close to these long-necked creatures as you feed them by hand and after a brief induction, head out on a leisurely stroll up and down the mountain together.

Duration: approx. 2 hours in total, of which around 30 minute walk with a break (all-terrain buggies and baby carriers recommended)

Note: children under the age of 6 cannot guide the animals, but can come along and enjoy the experience. For children aged 6–9, an adult must accompany a child, while children aged 10 and over do not need to be accompanied. Dogs not permitted! The event will also take place if there is light rain. 

# Ritter von Hohenegg workshop **Guided tour hammer mill**


