## At the Grünes Haus **Museum visit**

The rich green color gives this stately town house its name. The facade was designed by Johann Jakob Zeiller in 1779. Inside, you will find beautiful murals and 11 stucco ceilings. A diverse collection is displayed in approximately 550 m<sup>2</sup> of exhibition space.

On display are valuable paintings by the Zeiller family of painters, as well as works by Anna Stainer-Knittel, known as "Geierwally." Visit the clock cabinet and the original tavern and discover archaeological finds from the region. The impressive Rodfuhrtafeln tell of the past heyday of the salt trade in Reutte.
